Venue of the Conference: Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University

The conference will be attended by leading Ukrainian and foreign scientists.

Important dates:

Jun 10 – deadline for materials;

Jun 20 – notification of acceptance of the report;

9 September – conference.

Conference languages:

Ukrainian and English.

The publication of the collection of scientific papers is scheduled before the conference

Conference objectives:

1. Trends and strategies of the open educational resources development.
2. Formation of the university’s open educational e-environment as a factor of increasing the quality of education.
3. Problems and prospects of interaction of the subjects in the open educational environment in the process of professional training.
4. Blended and distance learning as a way of access to quality education.
5. Lifelong Learning – the process and the motivation to use open educational resources

For participation in the conference we are asking till 10 Jun, 2016:

- 1) to create an account on the site <http://openedu.kubg.edu.ua/>, using the link “Account” in the top menu of the site;
- 2) to download the report / article, by selecting “Submit a report” on the main page.

All costs associated with the stay at the conference (travel, accommodation, meals, etc.) are to be paid by participants or by the party who is delegating participants.

Requirements for the articles submission:

The structure of the article should contain the following elements: stating the problem and its actuality; analysis of previous research, with which the author worked; isolating aspects that haven’t yet been studied sufficiently; formulation of goals and objectives of the article; presentation of the main material with the justification of the results; conclusions, recommendations, prospects for further research; list of sources used.

The volume of publication – from 0.4 (16 000) to 1 printed sheet (40 000 characters with spaces).

Specification. The text must be typed on a computer (Microsoft Office Word 2003 or later). Font: Times New Roman, size – 12 pt, line spacing – 1. All margins – 2.5 cm. Indentation – 1 cm.

Material presentation:

- 1) in the upper left corner – Bibliographic Index (without indentation);
- 2) the author's name in full (left-aligned, bold, 10 pt);
- 3) academic status, academic degree, position (left-aligned, 10 pt);
- 4) place of work: name of the institution, locality (left-aligned, 10 pt);
- 5) email (left-aligned, italic, 10 pt);
- 6) title of the publication (centred, half-bold, 12 pt, capital letters, without paragraph);

- 7) the word “Summary.” (half-bold, 10 pt). In the same line – the annotation of article of 600-800 characters (usual font, justification according to width, 10 pt);
- 8) the phrase “Key words:” (half-bold, 10 pt). In the same line – key words – 3-8 terms separated by “;” (usual font, justification according to width, 10pt, margins left and right – 1 cm.);
- 9) text body (usual font, justification according to width, 12pt);
- 10) Bibliography and other sources (in the original language and transliterated)
- 11) title of the publication, name, abstract and keywords in English (elements are presented as in Ukrainian). Important! Names and surnames of authors have to be transliterated in Latin from Ukrainian language according to the new standard of transliteration KMU 2010 (<http://translit.kh.ua/?passport>);
- 12) transliterated Latin list of references (REFERENCES (TRANSLATED AND TRANSLITERATED)), is presented similar to references.

Translated and transliterated in Latin a list of references (12 pt) is presented as following:

- the names of authors and proper nouns (magazines, publishing houses) are to be transliterated in Latin;
- the names of articles, conferences – translated in English;
- after each reference in brackets it is necessary to specify the language of the original source – (in Ukrainian) or (in Russian).

For transliteration we recommend to use the following online services: for sources in Ukrainian – “Ukrainian transliteration Standard” in passport standard mode (<http://translit.kh.ua/?passport>);

for the sources in Russian – “TRANSLYT.CC” (<http://translit.cc>).

ATTENTION! The Committee reserves the right to reject reports and articles that do not meet the above-mentioned requirements.
